
# Marshfield Municipal Airport, Roy Shwery Field Airport Management Report January 16th, 2023



There have been multiple days of sunshine and 40 degree temperatures that have Assited in boosting activity at the airport. We have seen aircraft that have been sitting for the last few months out of their hangars and flying again. This is typical as pilots who are fair weather flyers take advantage of the nicer temperatures and sunnier weather when they can.



In January a cover on the fuel farm was damaged due to the weight of the Oshkosh Truck with the plow. Fuel farm cover. This cover was a treated compressed wood cover that compromised already due to age and deterioration from exposure to the elements. The weight of the Oshkosh Truck being driven over it just further led to it's demise. We already had a



replacement cover in stock. Bob had to wait until warmer temperatures to replace the cover as the cover was frozen in place to the edges. Safety Cones have now been placed around the backside of the fuel farm so the plow vehicles will avoid that area when plowing in the winter.

Speaking of safety cones, Jeff ordered a set of safety cones from Amazon that we will keep at the airport to use for various things. During the winter we will keep them out by the fuel farm to make sure that the plow equipment does not drive over the large covers.

Rob Glab has started a Private Pilot / Drone Ground School at the Marshfield Airport through Duffy's Aircraft. We had the welcome surprise of having 19 students show up for the first class. There has been continued interests asking if this will be offered again in the summer months. The ground school is intended for the private pilot applicant or drone applicant to pass the computerized FAA exam that is part of each rating. The class will run every Tuesday for 12 weeks.

We recently welcomed a new temporary tenant to the airport. A Beech Bonanza will be hangared here on and off for the next few months as a traveling doctor will be working for the Marshfield Clinic. The doctor will be splitting his time between Marshfield and Wausau facilities.



The Wisconsin Bureau of Aeronautics sent out the annual required rates, charges and services survey of the airport. The survey is required to be filled out each year as part of our obligations for Federal and State funds. The survey is used for information purposes only. The results will be provided later so that airport management and committees and get a rough guess what rates, charges and services other airports are providing. At the end of the survey I added comments that they need to include for the future the new AvGas G100L as well as who has electrical charging stations at the airports and what rates they are charging for the use. Presently the survey asks for Jet A, 100LL, 94L Swift Fuel, and Auto fuel provided.

The Wisconsin Bureau of Aeronautics also sent out an invitation to the Land Use and Operations Seminar April 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at Hotel Mead in Wisconsin Rapids. The seminar is intended for airport managers, airport committee members, city officials and anyone else who have a hand in managing the airport. The cost is \$75 for both days or \$38 for a single day. The registration fee includes hot breakfast and lunches.





#### Types Of Aircraft That Have Visited Marshfield Per Year





#### This Month Compared To The Same Month Last Year




#### Percentage Of Operations ByType of Aircraft




Percentage Of Local And Transient Traffic For This Year





#### Hi Jeff,

I'm following up on previous phone conversation we had regarding MFI's runway lengths based on our Airports GIS (AGIS) surveys, which are required as part of the master plan project. We've received all the info we needed to help you make an informed decision on this topic, which is described below.

The runway lengths based on our surveys, which are required to be performed in accordance with FAA's policies and procedures, will result in updated published runway lengths that are less than the currently published runway lengths if we submit our current survey data. Details for each runway are as follows:

- RWY 16/34
  - Length on most recently approved ALP: 5,000'
  - Length in current flight publications: 5,002'
  - Surveyed runway length: 5,001'
- RWY 5/23
  - Length on most recently approved ALP: 3,600'
  - Length in current flight publications: 3,597'
  - Surveyed runway length: 3,595'

When we talked about this on the phone, you indicated that you don't want to see any reduction in runway lengths, if possible. One concern we discussed is whether we'd be able to rehabilitate/reconstruct a runway back to it's intended length in the future, or would we be required to build it back to the length it was previously surveyed at. I believe that the answer to this question could vary depending on a number of factors, but I wouldn't rule out the possibility that we may be required to build it back to the previously surveyed length.

An option to avoid possible reduction in published runway length would be for the City to repair/replace the pavement at the ends of the runway out to the intended length. Then, we'd come out and re-survey the ends. Melissa has indicated that doing this would not affect the overall schedule of the master plan.
